CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The 2009 SA Open Badminton Championships will be held at WA Satterley Hall, Badminton SA Headquarters, 42 Rutland Avenue Lockleys from Saturday 8th to Sunday 9th August 2009.
- The following grades will be offered:
Open: Singles, Doubles & Mixed Doubles (Best of 3 - Rally-Point)
A Grade: Singles, Doubles & Mixed Doubles (Best of 3 - Rally-Point)
- Eligibility is restricted to the following
Open: - All players
A GRADE: - All players except State League players
- Players will only be able to enter their own grade and/or one grade higher. Any player entering more than one grade may be called to play consecutive games with only a 15 minute break between matches.
- All South Australian based players must be a member of S.A.B.A. or they will incur a \$10 fee on top of their nomination fee.
- All Events will be played as a Knockout Format with a Plate event offered if sufficient entries are received. If sufficient entries are not received a Round Robin format will be played.
- Preliminary round matches will commence at:
A Grade Doubles – Tuesday 4th August at 7.30pm
A Grade Singles and Mixed Doubles - Saturday 8th August and conclude at 7.00pm.
Open Singles Doubles and Mixed Doubles - Saturday 8th and conclude at 7.00pm.
Semi-finals and Finals for both grades will commence at 9am on Sunday 9th August.
- The Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the laws of badminton as adopted by the I.B.F.
- Tournament draw and timing for the SA Open will be posted on the notice board in the social centre at Lockleys on **Monday 3rd August, 2009.**
- Please note that players not on the court within 5 minutes of their name being called shall forfeit the match. On-court warm-ups shall be restricted to 3 minutes.
- **ALL PLAYERS MUST BE AVAILABLE TO UMPIRE WHEN REQUESTED.**
- **Entry forms to include ALL FEES are to be posted to the Tournament Director at the address provided or placed in the Tournament Box at Badminton SA.**
All entries will be considered at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- Penalty for non-compliance of any rule or condition may mean forfeit of the match.
- **Tournament conditions may be altered at the discretion of the Tournament Committee**
- **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS: 8.00PM WEDNESDAY 29th JULY 2009.**

Badminton players in this tournament may be subject to In - Competition drug testing. Badminton players, coaches, officials and administrators of this tournament are subject to the Badminton Australia Anti-Doping Policy which has been endorsed by each State/Territory Association. Medications

Some medications contain prohibited substances. If a player suffers from a medical condition which can only be treated by medication containing a prohibited or banned substance, they must get approval to use this medication. 1. ATUE – Abbreviated Therapeutic Use Exemption Process

2. TUE – Therapeutic Use Exemption Process

For all other conditions and use of medications with banned substances, submit the TUE Form to the Australian Sports Drug Medical Advisory Committee (ASDMAC) with supporting documentation. See the ASDA website.
